Technology is being used to address some of the most complex problems communities face. Young people in this world will need strong digital skills, literacy, and numeracy. For children in northern Ghana, in isolated and rural communities, they are at risk of being left behind.

AfriKids helps young people and families leverage technology to address the problems in their lives and their communities.

We use digital tools to enhance primary children's learning, we use mobile banking & blockchain technologies in our microfinance, and use robotics & engineering kits to bring school science practicals to life.

How does AfriKids use technology to support children and their families?

Means

Local people have solutions to the problems they face, they just do not always have the means to affect change. AfriKids' livelihoods and microfinance put the power into their hands. We use technology to aid this through the use of mobile banking for disbursement of microfinance and we have used blockchain technology in Shea Nut production to make sure everyone gets their fair share of profit.

We work with communities to build understanding on the value of education, particularly girls', and the importance of community involvement and ownership of their schools. With this revitalised understanding we work with Parent Teacher Associations to develop School Improvement Plans and strategise how to provide learners with the IT & STEM resources they need for a quality education.
